

NOTICE OF ELECTION

TO: THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF NUECES COUNTY, TEXAS WHO RESIDE IN NUECES COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 AND WHO RESIDE WITHIN THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION BOUNDARIES OF NUECES COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1:

The Board of Emergency Services Commissioners of NUECES COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 has issued an Order calling for an election to be held on November 4, 2025 from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M., at which election all eligible voters residing within the boundaries of NUECES COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 and residing within the proposed annexation boundaries of NUECES COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 will be entitled to vote on the following:

Annexation – Texas Health and Safety Code § 775.051

Proposition A:

FOR

Adding the area generally located south of Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 1 which is located between Robstown and Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 4 and the area located generally south of Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 1 and north of Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 3, excluding the municipal limits of Robstown, to the Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 1.

AGAINST

Proposition B:

FOR

The area generally located south of Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 1 which is located between Robstown and Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 4 and the area located generally south of Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 1 and north of Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 3, excluding the municipal limits of Robstown assuming its proportionate share of the outstanding debts and taxes of the Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 1, if it is added to the district

AGAINST

LOCATIONS OF POLLING PLACES: Qualified voters residing in the Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 1 and residing within the proposed annexation boundaries of Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 1 will be entitled to vote at any of the polling locations on Election Day as described in Attachment 1, below.

EARLY VOTING: Early voting shall be conducted by County Clerk **Kara Sands**, the Early Voting Clerk, from October 20, 2025, through October 31, 2025. During early voting, qualified voters residing in the Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 1 and residing within the proposed annexation boundaries of Nueces County Emergency Services District No. 1 will be entitled to vote at any of the Early Voting polling places as described in Attachment 2, below.
